In thinking about this lesson and the vocabulary, and fully reaching the depth of the CCSS 4.OA.2, I want to stress to my students about how multiplication comparison situations involve the reciprocal of a number. For example, if one group is five times as large as a smaller group, the smaller group is the reciprocal of 5, or $1/5$ the size of the larger group.

Word Problems: Multiplicative Comparison A red umbrella costs \$8.00. A blue umbrella costs 3 times as much as the red umbrella. How much does the blue umbrella cost? Tom ran 4 laps of the football field. Sam ran 5 times as many laps of the football field. How many laps did Sam run? A pack of six pencils costs five times as much as a single pencil.

Solving Multiplicative Comparison Word Problems

Multiplication as Comparing. In multiplicative comparison problems, there are two different sets being compared. The first set contains a certain number of items. The second set contains multiple copies of the first set. Any two factors and their product can be read as a comparison. Let's look at a basic multiplication equation: $4 \times 2 = 8$.

Comparison word problems in elementary schools Students may start solving comparison word problems as early as first grade. Then, these problems get more and more challenging in 4th or 5th grade. There are two types of comparison in math: additive and multiplicative.

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
