ATLS now recommends that only 1 L of crystalloid fluid is provided during the initial assessment, and that blood products are moved on to quickly in patients that do not respond to the crystalloid. Airway and ventilation. The nature and methodology of the rapid assessment of the airway remain unchanged.

**What's New in Trauma? (ATLS 10th Edition Updates...**

For how long is an ATLS student status current? After the successful completion of the ATLS Student or Student Refresher course, your ATLS status is current for four years from the last date of the course. **Advanced Trauma Life Support FAQs**

Initially provide rescue breaths using an ambu bag and a mask at full flow oxygen. Perform continued assessment of airway patency while giving breaths. Have the person doing chest compressions pause during the 2 rescue breaths.

**ACLS Algorithms 2020 (Advanced Cardiac Life Support)**

Originally designed for emergency situations where only one doctor and one nurse are present, ATLS is now widely accepted as the standard of care for initial assessment and treatment in trauma centers. The premise of the ATLS program is to treat the greatest threat to life first.

Acute Coronary Syndromes Algorithm. For this case, you use the Acute Coronary Syndromes Algorithm to guide the assessment and management of patients with signs and symptoms of acute coronary syndromes. A key focus of the case is the identification and treatment of ST-segment elevation myocardial infarction (STEMI).

**Algorithms for Advanced Cardiac Life Support 2020**

Avoid prolonged hyperventilation with PCO2 <25 mm Hg Systolic Blood Pressure Guidelines >100 mm Hg for patients 50–69 years >110 mm Hg or higher for patients ages 15–49 or older than 70 years

The ACLS recommendations in the 2010 guidelines 13 and the 2015 AHA guidelines update 12 state that it is reasonable to consider administering a 1-mg dose of intravenous/intraosseous epinephrine every 3 to 5 minutes during adult CPR.

**2019 American Heart Association Focused... - Circulation**

The 2015 ACLS guidelines are the most recent published guidelines. Therefore the 2020 ACLS guidelines are actually the 2015 ACLS guidelines. Every 5 years the American Heart Association has a meeting, and they hammer out new CPR, BLS, ACLS and PALS guidelines. These guidelines are built upon data collected from the previous 5 years.
