Concrete is mixed by any two methods, based on requirement as per quality and quantity of concrete required. Normally for mass concrete, where good quality of concrete is required, mechanical mixer is used. Mixing by hand is employed only to specific cases where quality control is not of much importance and quantity of concrete required is less. Stone aggregate is washed with water to remove dirt, dust or any other foreign material before mixing.

The simple truth of the matter is, once the last of the concrete trickles out of the drum or dribbles out of the pump, the truck isn't empty. A small amount of concrete always remains inside the truck, especially in drum mixers. You can wash the truck out, run water through the drum while it rotates and even pressure-wash the inside.

How Cement Mixers Work | HowStuffWorks
1. Position ready mix truck under the wa-ter spout and run mixer at mixing speed. 2. Add 200 gallons of water or recycled wash water. Adding water while the mixer is at mixing speed will clean the mixer blades near the discharge opening. 3. Run mixer at mixing speed for at least two minutes. 4. Reverse mixer and discharge slurry in appropriate location. 5.

Cleaning out fresh and hardened concrete C
At a central or portable ready-mix plant, concrete should be discharged from a truck mixer or agitator truck within two hours. If non-agitating transporting equipment is used, this time is reduced to one hour. All delays must be avoided in order prevent honeycombing, as shown in Figure 1, or cold joints.
