CAVE AND ROCK ART. Nothing so far discovered in Britain can match the cave paintings of southern Europe, some dating from more than 30,000 years ago. But in 2003 over 80 engravings and reliefs were identified in caves at Creswell Crags in Derbyshire. There too, in 1876, was found the earliest known English ' mobile ' figurative art – the strikingly realistic head of a wild horse scratched on a rib bone, between 11,000 and 13,000 years old.
