So, another translation of the Odyssey; in summary, this is very modern and fast-moving as Mitchell has stripped out many of the epithets of the original claiming, in his introduction, that they are 'irrelevant' and 'sometimes inappropriate' - he's right, of course, that they are metrical fillers but, at the same time, they give the verse a stately gravity and flow that rolls through the lines and removing them, for me, also strips away some of the feel of Greek archaic epic.
